**Abstract:** Studies on the history of Malay kingdoms in West Kalimantan have largely focused on male rulers, leaving female leadership relatively underexplored. This study examines the leadership of Ratu Mas Jaintan in the Sukadana-Landak Kingdom from a socio-economic historical perspective. The research employs a historical method with an interdisciplinary approach integrating social and economic analysis. Data were collected from manuscripts, archival documents, artifacts, oral traditions, and previous studies, supported by field research and analyzed through historical criticism and comparative analysis. The findings show that Ratu Mas Jaintan played a significant role in shaping the socio-economic life of the kingdom by promoting open trade, regulating the use of natural resources such as diamonds and gold, and supporting agricultural activities. These policies strengthened regional trade networks while maintaining social stability and cultural continuity. This study contributes to the historiography of Southeast Asian history by highlighting the strategic role of female leadership in managing economic networks and political authority in Malay kingdoms. It also provides broader implications for understanding gender and power relations in historical governance and the importance of female leadership in socio-economic development in early Southeast Asian societies.

The following comments were received from reviewers.

### Reviewer 1:

Recommendation: Revisions Required (minor)

- The revised manuscript shows clear improvement, especially in the abstract, introduction, and discussion, which now better highlight the research focus and contribution to historiography
- The discussion section is stronger and more analytical, with the inclusion of relevant theories such as gender, leadership, and Southeast Asian trade networks
- However, parts of the discussion are still somewhat descriptive and need sharper analytical connections between findings and specific theories
- The main argument (thesis) of the article should be stated more clearly at the beginning of the discussion section
- Some references are less directly relevant to the topic and could be refined by prioritizing key works in Southeast Asian historiography and gender studies
- Minor language polishing is still needed to improve clarity, sentence flow, and academic tone
- Overall, the manuscript is significantly improved and close to publication standard, but would benefit from final refinement in analytical depth and coherence

The following comments were received from reviewers.

**Reviewer 1:**

Recommendation: Revisions Required

The manuscript discusses the leadership of Ratu Mas Jaintan and her role in shaping the social and economic life of the Sukadana and Landak kingdoms. The topic is interesting and contributes to the study of female leadership in regional history. The article is well structured and provides useful historical information, especially regarding trade networks and natural resource management. However, several aspects need improvement. The research gap and novelty are not clearly explained, and the introduction still reads mostly as a descriptive historical narrative. The methodology section remains quite general and should explain more clearly how the sources were analyzed. In addition, the discussion should connect the findings more strongly with previous studies and relevant theories. The English language also requires revision to improve clarity and academic style. Overall, the manuscript has potential but requires **major revision** before it can be considered for publication.

**Reviewer 2:**

Recommendation: Revisions Required

The discussion section would be stronger if the findings were connected more clearly to existing theories and previous studies. Since the article focuses on female leadership and economic management in a historical kingdom, the author could engage with studies on gender and power in historical leadership, such as the works of Joan W. Scott on gender as a category of historical analysis or research on women and political authority in Southeast Asia. In addition, the economic aspects of the Sukadana-Landak Kingdom could be discussed using perspectives from maritime trade and political economy in Southeast Asian history, for example the studies of Anthony Reid on early modern Southeast Asian trade networks. Incorporating these theoretical perspectives and comparative studies would help place the findings within broader historiographical debates and strengthen the analytical depth of the discussion.
